

Tan Doo Doo's Christmas Drinks - Matching

Tan A cup-shaped receptacle made of hard material, in which ingredients are crushed or ground

Doo Doo The dried bark of a small tree native to the Northern Caribbean and South Florida

All and An aromatic leaf commonly used in cooking

Sundry

Mortar A stick used for stirring still drinks or taking the fizz out of sparkling ones

Pestle An affectionate name you call someone (Deaux-Deaux)

Tom Tom The process a substance goes through to create effervescence and in some cases, alcohol

Draw Everyone

Sediment A vessel made of clay with a wide mouth and no handles

Ferment Short for "aunty"

Bay Leaf Matter that settles to the bottom of a liquid

Aluminum Pot A dish made of pounded plantains

Earthenware To allow ingredients to soak in a liquid until the liquid takes on the flavor of the ingredients

Mauby Bark

A heavy tool with a rounded end, used for crushing and grinding substances such as spices

Legend Cookware made of aluminum

Swizzle Stick A genre of folklore that consists of a narrative featuring human actions perceived or believed both by teller

and listeners to have taken place within human history
